The music is divided into three levels of difficulty. You may play one or all pieces or levels, or any number of notes in a given piece. The half measure will be ~ metronome marking 108. Bandleader Louise McClure recommends learning at least one or two of the "easy" pieces first. The point is to have fun and not stress out.

Some tips for faking: play the first note(s) of each measure. If you can follow the printed notes with your eyes, even if you can't play them yet, you're halfway there. Some people learn best just by listening to the tune several times through before starting to "fiddle" with it, or even by watching someone else's fingers.

Also: Feel free to play the tunes you know and dance the rest of the time.
